



# Divisional Formats

- 4 Teams:** Round Robin within division. At the end of the Round Robin the top 2 teams will play in the Championship Game.
- 6 Teams:** Single Division. Teams will play 3 preliminary games. The Top 2 Teams will play in the Championship game.
- 8 Teams:** 2 Sub-Divisions of 4 teams each. Teams will play a Round Robin within their Sub-division. The top teams in each Sub-division will play in the Championship game.

In the event there is a tie for divisional winner, the Tournament Tie-Breaker system will be employed.  
A detailed copy of this will be provided upon arrival at the arenas

## Game Times

*We will resurface the ice between the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> periods of each game  
(Not prior to the start of the game)*

<b>Little NHL Divisions</b>	(2) Ten-minute Stop Time Periods (1) Twelve-minute Stop Time Periods
<b>Mite/Novice Division</b>	(2) Ten-minute Stop Time Periods (1) Twelve-minute Stop Time Periods
<b>Squirt/Atom Division</b>	(1) Ten-minute Stop Time Periods (2) Twelve-minute Stop Time Periods
<b>Pee Wee Division</b>	(3) Twelve-minute Stop Time Periods
<b>Bantam Division</b>	(2) Twelve-minute Stop Time Periods (1) Fourteen-minute Stop Time Periods
<b>Midget Division</b>	(2) Twelve-minute Stop Time Periods (1) Fourteen-minute Stop Time Periods

## Tournament Point System

The Tournament will be using a **5-point** system to determine divisional standings.

<b>2 Points for a WIN</b>
<b>1 Point for a TIE</b>
<b>0 Points for a LOSS</b>
<b>+ 1 Point for each Period WON</b>
<b>+ ½ Point for each Period TIED</b>
<b>For a maximum of 5 pts available each game)</b>
